ICAR Trends

Common strengths:

- Staff are trained and can demonstrate proper donning and doffing procedures
- Hand Hygiene
- Contact Time
- Screening visitors and staff
- COVID-19 Testing



ICAR Trends

Common areas of improvement:

- Lack of staffing
- Not all necessary staff are fit tested to wear N95s
- Including a compliance audit with PPE, hand hygiene, environmental cleaning.
- Staffing knowing their role involved in environmental cleaning
- Easy identification of clean and dirty equipment
- Terminal Cleaning Checklists



Reports

- Healthcare Worker Influenza Vaccination Data
 - Request in early April
- > 2021 Statewide Antibiogram
 - Data due April 29th 2022
- Ambulatory Surgery Centers
 - Quarter 1 data (Jan 1st to Mar 31st) due on or before May 30th.
 - Quarter 2 data (Apr 1st to Jun 30th) due on or before Aug 29th.
 - Quarter 3 data (Jul 1st to Sep 30th) due on or before Nov 29th.
 - Quarter 4 data (Oct 1st to Dec 31st) due on or before Mar 1st.
